Code of Conduct

The North YUAG undertake to provide the Young Umpires on the North Promising List with the following –

- Opportunities to develop umpiring skills by appointing to youth matches in the Regional programme
- Suitably qualified and CRB checked Coaches/mentors of the appropriate standard to help develop umpiring skills
- Assistance so that the young umpire will reach his/her potential at Regional level

In return Young Umpires on the North Promising List undertake to –

- **Provide up to date contact details to the Young Umpire Coordinator and ensure details are correct on the website**
- **Reply to requests for information regarding availability for events within 5 days of the request at the latest by checking the website regularly and updating availability**
- **Confirm receipt of appointments immediately and let the YU Coordinator if you become unavailable for the event. If there is any doubt about your fitness/availability let the YU YU Coordinator know**
- Wear smart umpiring uniform and ensure correct umpiring equipment at each match/training
- Ensure you arrive on time for training sessions and matches/tournaments
- Show respect for colleagues, coaches, mentors, officials and players
- Never publicly express any criticism of umpires or officials or players
- Apply the rules of hockey fairly and have regard to protecting the players through the application of the rules of the game
- Never participate when under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- Never use inappropriate language or gestures
